Mr. Parks serves as the USSTRATCOM Directorate of Capability and Resource Integration (J8) liaison to US Joint Forces Command (JFCOM). His primary focus is establishing collaborative relationships between Combatant Commands and external agencies to better exchange cyberspace planning, organization, analysis, and concept development and experimentation opportunities. Mr. Parks has over 28 years of experience at all levels to include White House Programs and Operations, Joint Staff, Secretary of the Air Force, Major Commands and operational wings. Mr. Parks served as a combat pilot in multiple leadership positions to include Deputy Operations Group Commander, Commander, Operation Officer, Instructor, evaluator, and operational test and evaluation pilot. Mr. Parks flew over 150 Presidential Support Missions, in support of Presidents Clinton and Bush, to include 9/11 response to the World Trade Center attack. He also led the first-ever testing of precision munitions onboard the B-52. His staff duties include service on the Joint Staff and as the Deputy Director of Intelligence and the Director of Air Force Experimentation Office with the Secretary of Air Force's Warfighting Integration Directorate. Mr. Parks led the Department of Defense (DoD) largest operational warfighting Joint Expeditionary Force Experiment (JEFX) design, execution and transition of warfighting capabilities in 2004 and 2006 and spearheaded the \$1B dollar upgrade to the Air Forces' Distributed Common Ground Station (DCGS) Mr. Parks was a 4-year ROTC Distinguished Graduate, Distinguished Graduate and Outstanding Performer, B-52 Combat Crew Training School and Combat Flight Instructor's Course respectively and a Joint Specialty Officer.
